Group 5 - Roll no. 29 to 35



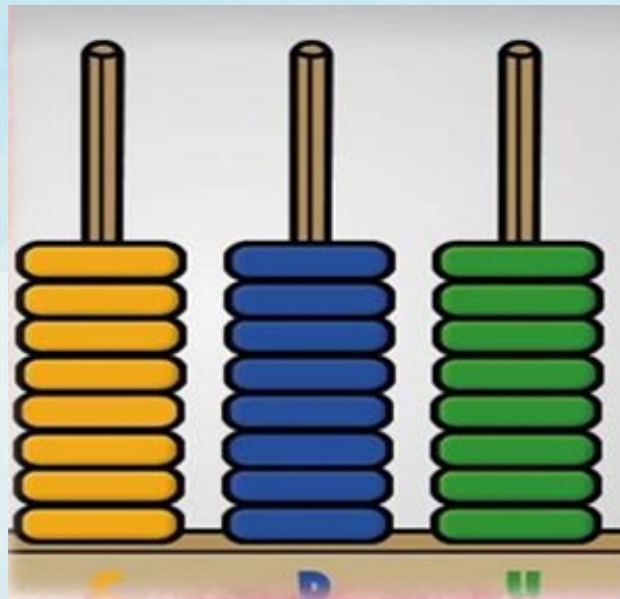
