






# SEVEN WONDERS OF THE WORLD










The objective of the Holiday Homework is to develop the following

### 3. \*\*Academic Review:\*\*


- Concept Revision: Take the opportunity to review and reinforce previously learned concepts, ensuring retention and understanding of foundational knowledge.



### The Colosseum


The Colosseum, also named the Flavian Amphitheater, is a large amphitheater in Rome. It was built during the reign of the Flavian emperors as a gift to the Roman people. Construction of the Colosseum began sometime between C.E. 70 and 72 under the emperor Vespasian. It opened nearly a decade later and was modified several times in the following years. The massive structure included eighty entrances to the amphitheater. The sheer number of entrances proved to be necessary: the Colosseum could hold more than 50,000 spectators at its maximum capacity. Aside from the games, the Colosseum also hosted dramas, reenactments, and even public executions. After the fall of the Western Roman Empire, the Colosseum began to deteriorate. Nevertheless, a restoration project began in the 1990s to repair the Colosseum. Today it is one of modern-day Rome's most popular tourist attractions, hosting millions of visitors a year.












