Activities

- Watering Plants: Encourage your children to water the plants regularly.
- Nature Walks: take the children on short nature walks around the garden or nearby green spaces.
- Garden Art: Provide materials like colored chalk, paint, or crayons, and let the children create garden-themed art outdoors, and share the pictures with the class teacher.
- Storytime in the Garden: Set up a cozy outdoor reading corner with bedsheets or cushions and read garden-themed books to the children.


















Trace Standing & Sleeping Lines




























