

!Thread big beads


!Turn the pages of books

- ! Share things with your friends. Learn to throw waste in the dustbin.



















Popcorn Sensory Bin: Fill a tub with popcorn kernels or cotton balls, hide small toys thate, and let the child explore and find

Rhyme Time: Recite carnival-themed rhymes like:



- "I'm a little clown so small and funny..."








Donut Number Pom Pom Activity (Roll No 1 - 10)












Make a doughnut using cardboard/

Coloured Ice Cream Stick Activity (Roll No 11 - 20)





- ! Dress Up Fun: Dress up as a clown or a character from a carnival. Take a photo and paste it on the A4-sized sheet and decorate it.




















